Mission


Promote the history and preserve the traditions of the Military Police Corps Regiment while supporting Military Police Leadership, Soldiers and Families Army wide.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Scholarships are awarded annually to dependents of Standard Members. Students may be enrolled, or planning to enroll, in an accredited college or university. Established in 2006, this fund provides educational tools to recipients and is made possible through generous contributions from friends of the MPRA and from proceeds from a variety of fundraising efforts.

This scholarship, made possible by the unwavering support of friends and dedicated fundraising efforts, has awarded \$491,000 to 576 family members, empowering them to pursue their educational goals and chase their dreams. Many recipients have gone on to earn degrees in fields like nursing, engineering, and computer science, while others have used their scholarships to pursue careers in law enforcement and public service.

AWARDS



Order of the Marechaussee

The Order of the Marechaussee award recognizes a degree of professionalism, high standards of integrity and morality, and esprit de corps consistent with the long standing history and traditions of our Corps.

GOLD: Nominees must have rendered at least 25 years of significant service or support to the Corps. They must have held key positions of strategic significance, served admirably, and made a considerable and lasting impact on the Corps. Approved by the Commandant, recipients must maintain the highest character and have performed considerable accomplishments to and for the Corps.

SILVER: Nominees must have rendered at least 20 years of significant service or support to the Corps. They must have made an outstanding and positive impact in various positions of increased responsibility during their period of service and clearly stand out from their peers in the opinions of their superiors, subordinates, and peers alike.

BRONZE: Nominees must have rendered at least 10 years of significant service or support to the Corps. They must have made an outstanding and positive impact in various positions of increased responsibility during their period of service and clearly stand out from their peers in the opinions of their superiors, subordinates, and peers alike.

STEEL: Nominees must have performed service to the Corps and have less than 10 years of service as a 31-series, 311A, job series 1811 CID Special Agent, 0083 Police Officer (Soldier or Civilian), or 0085 Security Guard. Acts of valor, regardless of the number of years of service to the Corps, will be considered.

Order of the Vivandieres

Officially established in 2005, the award recognizes spouses who voluntarily make significant contributions to the morale, welfare, and spirit of Soldiers and family members in Military Police Corps units. In keeping with the traditions



of the Corps, this award symbolizes the historical significance and preserves the traditions of military spouses, as well as recognizes the recipient's tremendous sacrifice and support for Soldiers and families through volunteerism.

Friend of the Regiment

During the Regimental Anniversary Ball at Fort Leonard Wood in 2018, this award was official established to recognize individuals who voluntarily make significant contributions to the morale, welfare, and spirit of Soldiers and Family members in various facets of the Police Corps.
