

**The Annual 25<sup>th</sup> MP Company & Hawaii MP Alumni Reunion**

Greetings from the Lake of the Ozarks (LOTO) to all of our alumni and families! We have a great reunion planned for all of you here at our lake, which we locals affectionately call “The Redneck Riviera.” Here is some key information you’ll need to know.

**Lodging.** The Resort at the Lake of the Ozarks is conveniently located just two miles from the historic Bagnell Dam strip, which is famous for its unique collection of specialty shops, boutiques, restaurants, night life, events, and galleries. The resort has over 155 smoke-free guest rooms and suites where you can relax and spend your days taking in all that lake-life has to offer. Everything that you would like to experience at this locale is just outside of your door.

The room rate is \$110.00 per night, plus resort/destination fees, and of course ... taxes. This rate and the reservation block for 25<sup>th</sup> MP Company & Hawaii MP Alumni will be held until July 22, 2026. Guestrooms not confirmed after this date will be released to the general public and reservations will be subject to availability. An additional five rooms are blocked for those early birds that want to arrive on Wednesday/October 7<sup>th</sup>. The rate will also apply for up to 3 days before or after our blocked window in the event that our guests want to arrive earlier or stay longer given that this is the Columbus Day Weekend.

All guest rooms are equipped with refrigerators and microwaves, high-definition flat-screen TVs with HD cable programming, in-room Wi-Fi, coffee makers, and hair dryers. All rooms include complimentary grab-and-go continental breakfast in the lobby. The resort also offers pet-friendly and handicap-accessible rooms. For additional cost, you may upgrade to one of the lake-facing rooms or townhouse suites. Our block of rooms features comfort and convenience, large work desks and convenient lap desks, and in-room amenities include:

- One King, double Queen, or King-single/Queen beds
- Free on-site parking
- 24-hour coffee/tea in the lobby
- Iron/ironing board
- Gym/fitness center
- Game Room
- Indoor pool
- Outdoor pool & swim bar
- Room service

Please call Resort at the Lake of the Ozarks at (573) 693-9988 and ask for the 25<sup>th</sup> MP Company & Hawaii MP Alumni room reservation block. Reservations must be made by **Wednesday, July 22, 2026**. There are limited hotel shuttle services based on need and availability.

**Airport Transportation.** For those air travelers that choose to fly to this year’s reunion, I recommend that you fly into the St. Louis Lambert International Airport, 10701 Lambert International Blvd, St. Louis, MO 63145. This airport is approximately 162 miles from the hotel. It services most major air carriers - American, Delta, United, Southwest, and many others.

Another option is the Springfield-Branson National Airport, 2300 N Airport Blvd, Springfield, MO 65802. This is a smaller, regional airport with limited flights and services. This airport is approximately 95.6 miles from the resort.

**Hospitality Suite and Missouri Meeting Room.** The hospitality suite is located in a convenient and easily accessible wing of the resort. It's the largest room in the facility and is equipped with all of the important features we need. It can accommodate up to 150 of our alumni, family members, and guests. We have also reserved an adjoining, smaller break-out room (Missouri Meeting Room) that can accommodate 40 additional guests who seek a quieter and more reserved atmosphere for cards, games, and fellowship. So be prepared to kick back, relax, and take as much elbow room as you need. The hospitality suite and Missouri Meeting Room will be open Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 8:00 am – 12:00 AM. We will have a limited open bar (a necessary cost constraint) each day; all alcoholic beverages must stay in the hospitality suite or Missouri Meeting Room. Daily finger foods will be provided in-house as the resort does not allow outside food or beverages.

**Reunion Fee.** The reunion fee will be \$125.00 per person. This will cover the following costs:
